





- × There are 12,589 licensed LPNs in Washington State.
- × There are 2.2 LPNs/1,000 Washington State residents. (Nationally there were 2.5 LPNs/1,000 residents in 1998.)
- ★ 83.1% of Washington State LPNs who responded to a survey at licensing said that they were actively working with their license.
- × In rural Washington locations, there are 2.2 LPNs/1,000 residents.
- ★ In urban Washington locations, there are 2.2 LPNs/1,000 residents.
